### 2023-2024 Upper School Supply List

In Upper School, teachers require that students establish an organizational system to use throughout the year, including:

- 1. a place for taking notes (bound notebooks or binder with loose leaf paper) and
- 2. a place for **keeping handouts** (an accordion folder, pocket dividers in a binder, or individual folders for each class).

We require the following list of supplies across disciplines in 2023-24:

- Loose-leaf graphing paper (one packet)
- Ruler
- Set of Sharpies (fine and/or thick tip, black or colored)
- Colored pencils
- 3-4 packs of notecards (3x5 and/or 4x6)
- Personal supply of writing implements (pens, pencils, highlighters, and erasers)
- Student weekly planner/agenda fitting your personal needs and assisting with academic organization

Additional Grade/Class Specific requirements (a few things overlap with the aforementioned, but I am noting the specific requests from the teachers below):

- 9th Spanish and new students taking Spanish: 100 page composition book
- 9th and 10th grade History classes: Highlighters (at least 2 different colors)
- 9th and 10th English: a dedicated 3 ring binder (ideally 1.5 inch size), and one 100 page composition book
- 9th and 10th grade: French 1 & 2: 1 inch binder and loose leaf paper
- 10th Biology: graphing composition notebook (for labs), a binder with dividers or accordion file, highlighters, markers or colored pencils, basic calculator
- 11th and 12th AP Biology: lined composition notebook (FRQs), graphing composition notebook, binder with dividers or accordion file, highlighters, markers or colored pencils
- 10th grade History: Standard 3" 3-Ring View Binder with Dividers
- 10th-12th graders: Graphing calculator TI-83/84 family (if replacing one's TI or if
  interested in a second calculator, Mr. Bennis suggests Numworks are a great additional
  option for Precalculus or Calculus please reach out to him with questions at

- 9th and 10th grade Geometry students: Protractor (and compass recommended)
- 12th grade Discrete Math: a dedicated 1.5-inch or 2-inch 3-ring binder with 6 dividers, a packet of loose leaf 3-hole-punched lined paper, set of post-it tabs (for tabbing books)



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Every day, Upper School students will need the following:

- 1. Laptop with wireless capability (and charging cord)
- 2. Calculator
- 3. Books needed for that day
- 4. Binders/notebooks needed for that day
- 5. Reusable Water Bottle\*
- 6. Reusable utensils for lunch
- 7. Reusable containers and lunchbox\*\*

Individual lockers will be assigned on the evening of August 21 during your back to school night visit; we welcome you to bring books and supplies that evening to place in your locker.

#### \*Reusable water bottles:

It is important to send students to school each day with a refillable water bottle. Students spend a lot of time outdoors during the day so staying hydrated is essential to help them feel their best! We have refilling stations in several locations around campus for them to refill as needed throughout the day. Any refillable water bottle will do but here are some examples if you need them: example water bottle another example

### \*\*Reusable lunch containers:

To help reduce the amount of single use plastic on our campus, we request that students come to school prepared with the items they need for their lunches- this includes utensils.
