Many items listed below do NOT have to be new. Woodlawn is committed to practicing sustainability whenever possible. Please look for items **highlighted in green**. For those items we encourage you to reuse or repurpose these supplies when possible.

- 2- 1 ½ -inch **3 ring binder with clear plastic cover** and pockets on the inside (LA/M)
- 2 pack of 5 binder **dividers with tabs**
- 3 wide-ruled **composition notebooks** (Spanish/Math/Sci)
- 6- 2-pocket **plastic folders with prong fasteners and 3 holes** (green, blue, red, orange, yellow, & purple)
- 1- 4-pack of felt tipped black pens : **flair pens**
- 2- 4 packs **low odor dry erase markers** with **old sock or rag** to use as dry erase marker eraser
- **2 pencil pouches with binder holes**
- 1 pack of **Crayola markers** (thin)
- 2 packs **thin fine-tip Sharpies**
- 1 Hand-held **pencil sharpener** with canister
- 3 **large pink erasers**
- At least 48 - **#2 Ticonderoga pencils** (sharpened)
- 1 **pack highlighters** (any color)
- 1 pack of **24 Crayola colored pencils**
- 1 pair of **scissors**
- **2 red pens**
- 1 **ruler with cm and inches**
- 1- Package ½ inch square grid paper **Example: 1/2 inch grid paper** or **Example: ½ inch grid paper**
- 1 pack of **wide-ruled loose leaf paper**
- 1 Package Construction Paper **Example: Tru-Ray Construction Paper**
- **Earbuds** (will stay at school- Music & Spanish)
- 1 box of **facial tissue**
- 1 canister of **disinfectant wipes**
- **Box of Gallon slider bags**
- **Box of Sandwich Size Ziploc Bags**
- 2 packs of lined Index cards (3 x 5) (Spanish/LA)
- 1 pack of Post-it Notes
- 1 pack of Glue Sticks
- 1 **packs of water color paints**
- **New students only:** 1 inch **binder with clear cover** (music)
- **New students only:** **Binder dividers** (music)
- **New students only:** **Art Sketchbook with at least 100 pages**
- **Compact auto-open umbrella with a string on handle to be kept at school**
- **Reusable water bottle** (labeled with name) to be sent to school each day
- **Laptop with wireless Internet capability (any laptop with access to Google Drive is acceptable)**



Note the following:

- Students should have a soft sleeve for their computer (slim line sleeves preferred). The computer power cord should come to school every day in their backpack. Students are responsible for charging their computer at home every night.
- Students need a laptop for classwork. iPads are not recommended.
- Only standard size student backpacks are permitted. Roller backpacks are not permitted.
- No permanent decorations are permitted on student lockers. Students may use magnetic decorations/accessories only on the interior of their locker. Students may find it helpful to have [locker shelf](#) inserts. Lockers are 12x12x36.

Materials for students to collect at home
