Many items listed below do NOT have to be new. Woodlawn is committed to practicing sustainability whenever possible. Please look for items highlighted in green. For those items we encourage you to reuse or repurpose these supplies when possible.

- Reusable water bottle (with name) to be sent to school each day
- (Optional) Agenda (choose one that fits personal needs) 5×8 or 8×10 (examples)
- 1 journal of your choice (Life Skills/Advisory) (example)
- 1 pkg. loose-leaf paper (college ruled, approx. 200 sheets) (Math)
- 1 Spiral bound notebook -<u>college</u> or <u>graph ruled</u> Does NOT need to be new. (Science)
- .5" <u>3-ring binder (Science)</u>
- 3.<u>Composition books</u> (<u>Plastic are recommended</u>) NOT spiral bound (Math, LA, Spanish)
- 5 paper or plastic folders with brads and pockets (Science, SS, LA, Math, Spanish)- variety of colors
- 1 pack of multi-colored highlighters
- At least 30 <u>#2 Ticonderoga pencils</u>, sharpened (Art & all classes)
- 1 pkg. of rectangular erasers (Art)
- 1 pkg. <u>Glue sticks</u> (Science, Math, Art)
- 1 Non-flexible plastic or wooden ruler (Math, Science)
- 1 pair of scissors
- 1 pack low-odor dry erase markers & old sock or rag to use as dry erase marker eraser (Math, Spanish)
- 1 pkg. of 12 or 24 not erasable <u>colored pencils</u> (SS, Science)
- Variety of <u>colored Sharpies</u> (Art)
- 1 pkg each fine and ultra fine tip black Sharpies (Art)
- 1 pack of Post-It notes (Art)
- 1 pack <u>Masking tape</u> (Art)
- 1 pack <u>Painters tape</u> (Art)
- Laptop with wireless Internet capability (any laptop with access to Google Drive is acceptable)
- Graphing Calculator (<u>TI 84 Plus series</u> or <u>TI-84 CE</u> or <u>Numworks</u>) It is used from 8th grade throughout Upper School as well as for the SAT. **Keep directions to use in class*
